LPG TANKS

<u>LPG Tank Clearance of Combustibles:</u> Weeds, grass, brush, trash, and other combustible materials shall be kept a minimum of 10 feet from LP-gas tanks or Containers.

<u>Protecting LPG containers from vehicles:</u> Where exposed to vehicular damage due to proximity to alleys, driveways or parking areas, LP-gas containers, regulators, and piping shall be protected.

VEHICLE IMPACT PROTECTION

<u>General:</u> Vehicle impact protection shall be provided by posts that comply with 2022 CFC Section 312.2 or by other approved physical barriers that comply with 2022 CFC Section 312.3.

FIRE WATER STORAGE

If the project is determined to be located in the State Responsibility Area (SRA), fire water storage may be required.

FIRE SPRINKLERS (Where required)

When Fire Sprinklers are required, three (3) sets of sprinkler plans, with flow calculations & cut sheets, shall be submitted to Tehama County Fire Department for review *prior to the start of construction*. Sprinkler plans and calculations shall be done by a Licensed C-16 contractor or mechanical engineer

Tehama County Fire Department only accepts an audible and visual notification device ("Horn Strobe") on all buildings requiring sprinklers systems. This device shall be located on the street side / address side of the building. This device shall remain fully visible and unobstructed.
